- 2 Essays answering the three provided questions. Each separate essay should be 250 words, no less than 200, and no more than 300. Less than 200 words will deem this application incomplete.
- 3 Copy of your most recent college transcript, which must indicate the following: cumulative grade point average and hours completed.
- 4 One recommendation letter from a professor, employer, or community leader that has known you for more than three years. This person may not be First Tee staff, or a direct family member.
- 5 (Optional) Any documentation providing information about extenuating circumstances affecting your ability to pursue your educational goals. This could be a letter to the committee, or whatever you deem appropriate to share your specific needs.
